



# Take Away Homework!

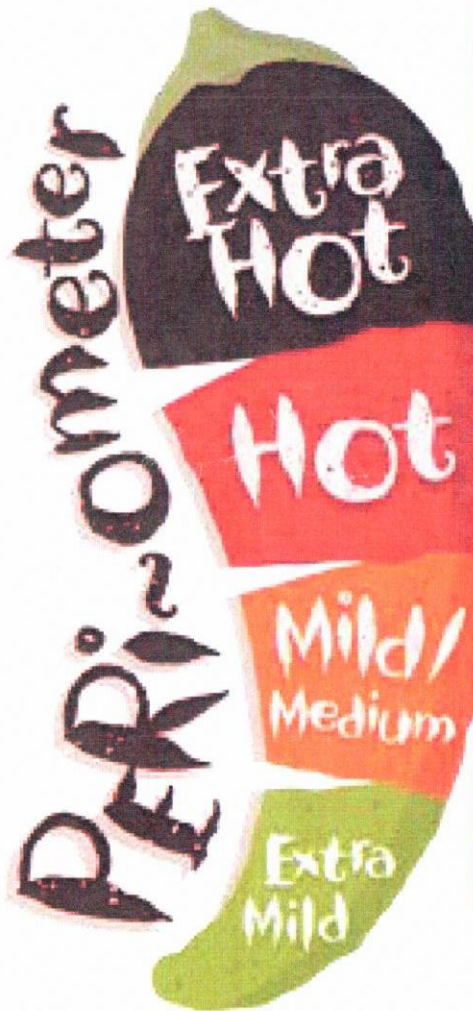


## Choose your homework from the menu below:
